Proposed Action:

1. To adopt the following continuing resolution to implement the change of the Advocacy Policy Council Task Force into a Committee. The Advocacy Policy Committee will set goals, objectives, and policy directions for Advocacy within the Southeastern Synod.
1. To appoint the following persons¹ as members of the ELCA-Advocacy Policy Committee. The committee will have nine members and members will serve a two-year term, but no more than two consecutive terms. Rev. Matt Steinhauer will serve as the Synod Staff Liason.

2. To request that the ELCA-Southeastern Synod Advocacy Policy Council
 - a. Elect a chair person and promptly report that person's name to the synod office
 - b. Report scheduled committee meeting dates and locations to the synod office for inclusion on the synod calendar
 - c. Provide written progress reports for all Synod Council meetings, as well as any resignation of committee members
3. Initial funding of \$35K for the Task Force came from an ELCA World Hunger Grant and matching Synod contributions. The expectation is that funding for the Committee will continue from these sources. This funding is used to pay for 25% of an Assistant to the Bishop.
