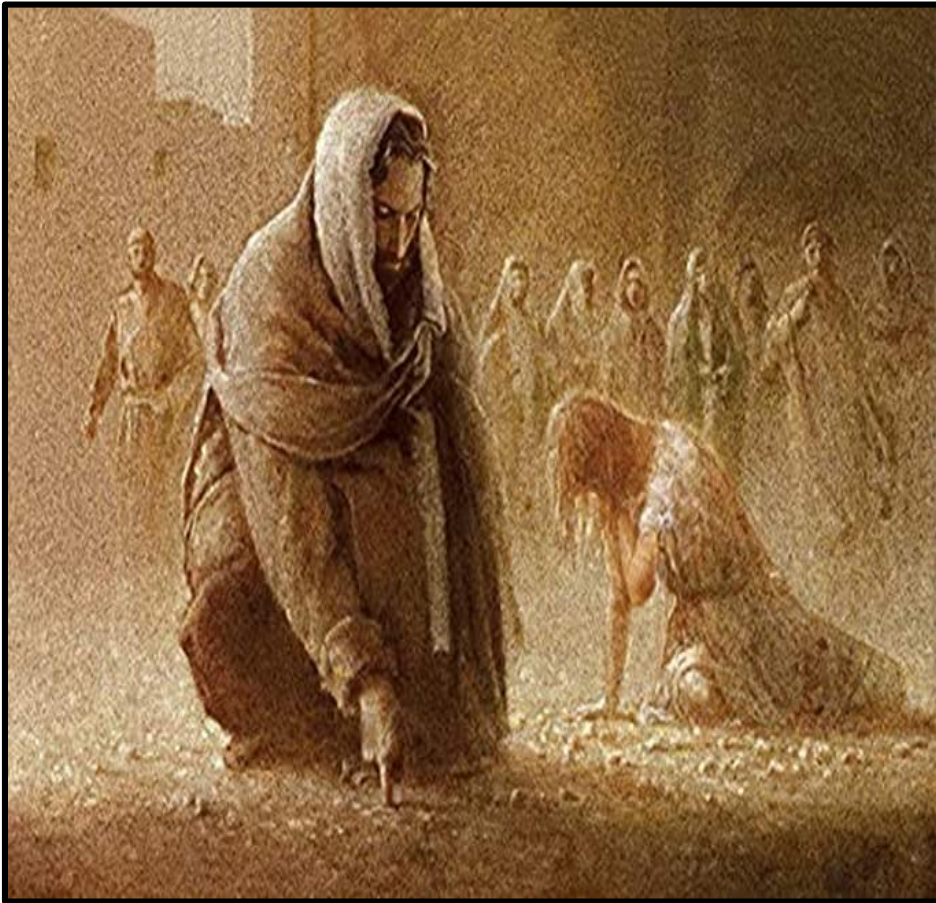


Step off the Curb:

Active Bystander Intervention Workshop offered June 12 in Kennesaw
